The present appeal has been preferred under Section 14A(2) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (as amended) against the order dated 25.07.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide which the bail application of the appellant stands dismissed.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.03.2023, the appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-33580-2022 is made absolute. However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
