By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.126 dated 23.06.2022 registered at Police Station Phase-I, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 406 & 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the orders passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 03.03.2023 and by this Court on 05.07.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Gajender Kumar by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 03.03.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
