1. This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.126 dated 26.06.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

2. There is no representation either on behalf of the parties.

3. Vide order dated 03.03.2023, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded; as to the genuineness of the compromise. In compliance thereof, report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran dated 20.03.2023, has been received, wherein, it has been mentioned that the parties did not appear to record their statements.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any further, the same is dismissed.
