Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial enquiry on the complaints dated 16.01.2023 and 22.02.2023 (Annexures P-5 and P-6), moved by the petitioners, for registration of FIR against private respondents for committing cheating/fraud of Rs.30 lakhs.
