Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.196 dated 26.11.2022 registered under Section 364, 364-A, 302, 201, 120-B IPC was added later on vide Rapat No.31 dated 17.12.2022 at Police Station Kotbhai District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Taking into consideration the allegations made in the FIR and the fact that the petitioner is less than 15 years of age, this Court finds that

the petitioner is required to approach the Juvenile Justice Board concerned for the relief of bail.

The counsel for the petitioner made prayer that the petitioner be given sufficient time to approach the Juvenile Justice Board concerned, as at present the annual examination of the petitioner are going on.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Juvenile Justice Board concerned within next 3 weeks and to seek bail in accordance with law. However the police is not to take any coercive action against the petitioner till next 3 weeks or till his appearance before Juvenile Justice Board, whichever is earlier.
