KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of FIR No.0184 dated 10.7.2018, under Sections 21, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).
2. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Ranvir Singh, informs this Court that out of total 13 witnesses, 11 witnesses have already been examined.
3. Therefore, at this stage, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the instant petition to exercise its powers envisaged under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the FIR, which is based upon merit. The instant petition is, hereby, dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to raise all such pleas before the learned trial Court concerned, which is raised before this Court at the appropriate stage.
4. Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
