The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the order/notice dated 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Police of P.S. Sadar Karnal, whereby the petitioner has been directed to deposit weapon in the Police Station.

Even on second call none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel while referring to the reply dated 21.05.2018 submits that though the petitioner had been asked to deposit his weapon, the District Magistrate, Karnal had asked the Superintendent of Police, Karnal that the arms licence and weapon was not required to be deposited and thus, the relief claimed by the petitioner has already been granted by the District Magistrate, Karnal.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
