Prayer made in the present writ petition is to direct respondent State of Punjab and the Panjab State Sports Council along with the Director Sports Punjab i.e. respondents No.1, 2 and 4 to form an Ad hoc Committee to administer the affairs and functions of respondent No.6 i.e. Punjab Handball Association and with a further prayer to ensure conduct of elections of the respondent No.6 association in accordance with the

Constitution of the Punjab Handball Association under the supervision of Ad hoc Committee.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties are *ad idem* that the present petition may be disposed of by appointing an Administrator to manage and supervise the affairs and functions of respondent No.6 for a period of 06 months and also to enable the Administrator to conduct elections within a period of 06 months, on receipt of a certified copy of this order, as per the constitution of the Punjab Handball Association.

In view of above consensus, Mr. Naresh Gopal Sharma, Advocate, (P-784-2001, Mobile No.9417045489) is appointed as an Administrator to conduct elections of the Punjab Handball Association i.e. respondent No.6 in accordance with the Constitution of Punjab Handball Association in conformity with the National Sports Development Code 2011 as well as to manage and supervise the affairs of the Punjab Handball Association till then. The lump sum fee of the Administrator for ensuring conduct of elections is assessed at Rs.1 Lakh to be paid by the petitioners.

Upon conduct of election, the Administrator shall hand over the charge of the Association to the duly elected body.

Disposed of accordingly.
