1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, direction or order especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 15.11.2017 (annexure P-12).

2. On 18.07.2023, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Written statement on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed today in the Court which is taken on record and a copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that a perusal of the impugned order would show that the request of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been rejected vide letter dated 02.11.2017 which has neither been annexed nor been challenged in the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a copy of the said letter has not been supplied to the petitioner.
