Short reply by way of affidavit of Harvinder Singh Cheema, DSP, Sub Division, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of the respondent-State has been placed on record.

The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No.264 dated 18.11.2000 under Sections 324/323/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jang Singh, submits that in fact, the FIR was registered 19.11.2000 and the date of registration of FIR has been wrongly mentioned as 18.11.2000 in the head note and prayer clause of the petition. It has been further submitted that after investigation, cancellation report was submitted and the same has been accepted in terms of the order dated 08.03.2021 passed by the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib. Consequently, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categorical assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. They shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
