Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to submit that accused Abhishek Vohra and Sumit Bhandari has filed a civil writ petition, i.e. CWP-11007-2016, and this Court has passed an order on 23.11.2016 directing the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners, therefore, they cannot be arrested. It is further submitted that the said writ petition is still pending.
