MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to investigate the case FIR No.23 dated 04.02.2023 under Sections 420/120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural in fair and impartial manner and for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to direct respondent No.4-bank to release the account No.50200037667961 of the petitioner from the condition of hold of ₹5,00,000/-.

2. Learned State counsel at the outset has drawn the attention of this Court to para 5 of the affidavit filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 to urge that despite repeated notices having been served upon the petitioner under Section 41-A of the Cr.P.C. to join investigation, he had been deliberately evading the same and had instead chosen to file the instant petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is willing to join investigation. He submits that as and when the next notice under Section 41-A of the Cr.P.C. is served upon the petitioner, he would appear before the investigating agency.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material on record.

5. In view of the reply filed by the learned State counsel and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not deem it fit to issue any directions as sought for by the petitioner.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
