This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 17.10.2019 (Annexure P-8), 07.08.2013 (Annexure P-6) and order dated 20.07.2011 (Annexure P-3) vide which the mutation has been sanctioned in favour of respondents no.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of para 27 of the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in **Jagjit Singh vs. Divisional Commissioner, Patiala and others**, reported as **2012(13) RCR (Civil) 96**, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points which have been raised in the present petition and are available to him, in the RSA which is pending adjudication.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
