The petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR No.31 dated 03.03.2017 under Sections 323/341/427/379/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

Vakalatnama filed by Mr. APS Rehan, Advocate on behalf of respondent No.2 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the submissions made by the State in its reply dated 16.08.2022, which is by way of an affidavit of Kulwinder Singh DSP, Mukerian, Hoshiarpur, the petitioner has been found to be innocent. Para 12 of the reply reads as under:-

“12. That it is submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order dated 20.07.2017 in CRM-M 18504 of 2017 passed by this Hon'ble Court, the then SSP, Hoshiarpur conducted inquiry into the matter of the main FIR and found Sarpanch Balbir Singh Tita, Kulbir Singh and Sarpanch Rajwant Kaur and Kuljit Singh to be innocent in the main case and the allegations leveled by complainant namely Rajnish Kumar of cross case regarding committing theft of Rs.70,000/- from his pocket was found to be false conducted by the then SSP, Hoshiarpur and as such offence u/s 379, 34 IPC was deleted from the cross case.”

In view of the above and as prayed for, this petition is permitted to be dismissed as withdrawn.
