CM-9103-C-2023

The present application has been moved under Order 22 Rules 4 and 11 for bringing on record the LR's of respondents No.1-Kaniya, respondent No.2- Bhuri and respondent No.3-Indraj. The LR's of the aforesaid respondents have been mentioned in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 respectively of the application. It has also been averred that apart from the aforesaid LR's, there is no other LR of the said respondents.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. LR's of respondents No.1-Kaniya, respondent No.2- Bhuri and respondent No.3-Indraj as mentioned in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of the application are ordered to be brought on record. Amended memo of parties is taken on record. The Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place in the case file.

Learned counsel submit that they have filed power of attorney on behalf of newly added LR's and would be representing them.

The present application has been moved under Order 22 Rules 3 and 11 for bringing on record the LR's of appellant No.2-Kehri and appellant No.4-Bhagwana. The LR's of the aforesaid appellants have been mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 respectively of the application. It has also been averred that apart from the aforesaid LR's, there is no other LR of the said appellants.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. LR's of appellant No.2-Kehri and appellant No.4-Bhagwana as mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the application are ordered to be brought on record. Amended memo of parties is taken on record. The Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place in the case file.

Learned counsel submit that they have filed power of attorney on behalf of newly added LR's and would be representing them.

CM-9104-C-2023 and CM-9107-C-2023

These applications have been moved by the appellants as also by the respondents seeking permission of the Court to place on record the compromise dated 28.07.2023, arrived at between the parties. Permission of the Court is sought to withdraw the present appeal as also the original civil suit No.58.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and a compromise deed dated 28.07.2023 has been executed which has been annexed with the present applications.

Learned counsel also submit that both sides shall remain bound by the said

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compromise.

For the reasons mentioned in the applications and in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the same are allowed.

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In view of the above, the present appeal is dismissed as having been withdrawn.

All other pending applications, if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
