The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0139 dated 27.10.2020 under Sections 457, 380 IPC and later on added Sections 379-B, 342, 506, 395 IPC registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.03.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 26.04.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 09.03.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.03.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
