KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case having FIR No. 60 dated 12.02.2022, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 325 and 326 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations made in the FIR no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner and further the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and got effected recovery of *kappa* used in commission of crime and now the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.03.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
