The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.139 dated 06.10.2022 registered under Sections 418, 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC (Sections 418, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.03.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
