The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 04.02.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-12595-2019, vide which, the plot in question, allotted to the petitioner, was restored on depositing the outstanding amount due against him, as per terms and conditions of the allotment letter.

As per affidavit filed by the Estate Officer, HSVPN, Hisar, which is on record, vide memo dated 08.06.2021, the plot No. 1761, Sector 33 P-I, Hisar stands restored to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are not adhering to the terms and conditions of the allotment letter and are claiming interest/penalty on the overdue amount.

The claim of the petitioner that the respondents cannot claim interest on the delayed payment is not sustainable in view of Clause 25 of the allotment letter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks

withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Rule stands discharged.
