The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.149, dated 21.04.2022, under Section 307 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25-54-59 of Arms Act, 1959 (later on added Section 201 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act), registered at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, District Rohtak along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 17.05.2023 directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements, in support of compromise as contended before the Court, and the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate was also directed to send its report.

In pursuance to the same, learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Rohtak has sent the report dated 29.05.2023 to this Court.

It has been mentioned therein that the complainant and his father made statement that the matter has not been compromised.

In view of the above position, when the present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise which is not supported by the complainant, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to avail their alternative remedies before the trial Court in accordance with law.
