The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant interest to the petitioner as sought in the legal notice dated 01.11.2019 (Annexure P-5).

Mr. Vikas Chatrath, Advocate has filed a short reply on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2 and submitted that the petitioner has already been granted interest @ 8.25% per annum and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the respondents-Bank and the short reply filed by them, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Since learned counsel for the petitioner is not present, in case, anything survives in the present petition then liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application, if so required.
