ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. At the relevant time, the petitioner was working as a Social Education and Panchayat Officer. Vide order dated 17.09.1992, he was given the Current Duty Charge of the post of Block Development and Panchayat Officer (BDPO). It was specifically stipulated that the petitioner shall not be entitled to any additional payment or any right of promotion on regular basis or seniority. The petitioner, on attaining the age of superannuation, retired on 31.10.1992. He filed the present writ petition in May, 1996 i.e. after a period of more than 3 years from his retirement.
2. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition on the ground that the petitioner in Civil Writ Petition No.3925 of 1994 (Gurmej Singh vs. State of Punjab and another) has been granted the similar relief.
3. If the petitioner would have filed a suit with respect to this matter, at this stage, the same may have been dismissed on the ground of limitation. Moreover, the petitioner never objected to such stipulation in the year, 1992 itself i.e. at time of taking the charge of the post of BDPO.

- 4. In view of the aforesaid discussion, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for is made out.
- 5. Dismissed.
- 6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
