Petitioner was allowed interim bail vide order dated 23.05.2017. Prayer in this petition is to quash the order dated 10.04.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar (Annexure P-6) and the order dated 03.11.2015 (Annexure P-4) of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nakodar, whereby the petitioner was summoned to face trial.

It is submitted by the learned State counsel that the trial is going on and two witnesses have already been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case the interim bail granted to the petitioner on 23.05.2017 is made absolute and that he withdraws his petition qua the prayer for quashing of the impugned orders.

Allowed as prayed for. Present petition for quashing the impugned orders is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the objections before the Trial Court in the pending trial.

However, the order dated 23.05.2017, whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail, is made absolute.
