Main case:

Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the notice dated 22.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) issued by the respondents vide which they have started the re-counseling process of the petitioners without even deciding their representation in view of the order dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by a Coordinate Bench and quashing the list (Annexure P-7) issued by the respondents showing the vacant posts for transfer of the Guest Teachers to the extent that the said posts

are meant for the petitioners Block Resources Persons/Assistant Block Resource Coordinators (BRP/ABRC).

Notice of motion.

Learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondent No.4 accept notice.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that in compliance of the judgment dated 14.09.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench in CWP-10692-2021, ample opportunities are being given to the petitioners, who are on contractual job, and the department is still in the process of giving postings to the petitioners. He undertakes that the directions issued in the aforesaid writ petition would be complied with and the postings would be given to the petitioners according to the options given by them.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the case file.

As stated by the learned counsel for respondent No.4 that the department is in the process of granting relief to the petitioners in compliance of the judgment passed by the Coordinate Bench in CWP-10692-2021, this Court finds that the present petition is premature and the petitioners are so eager to approach this Court.

In view of the above, no ground to grant the relief as prayed for is made out.
