SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to respondent No.2 to take immediate action under law on the complaint dated 22.1.2022 of the petitioner and proceed under various provisions of IPC against respondents No.3 to 10 for committing offence of forgery, cheating, misappropriation of funds in their capacity as bank officers.

Status report by way of an affidavit dated 27.03.2023 of Rajesh Kumar, (PPS) ACP, Civil Lines, (Temp. Charge) Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2-State has been filed in the Court. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel Referred to para No.3 of status report which reads as under:

That at very outset it is humbly submitted before this Hon'ble High Court that, on the basis of the written complaint (Exurban P-8) numbered as CR. No.2241164 dated 22.01.2022 submitted by the petitioner company through its Managing Director namely Rakesh Kumar to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and the recommendations made by the ACP (Detective-II) District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana in the preliminary investigation conducted in the aforesaid complaint, and further on the basis of the opinion of the DA (Legal), Ludhiana a FIR No.63 dated 18.03.2023 has been registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC at Police Station: Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana against unknown individuals.

In view of the above, since FIR has been registered no cause of action survives with the petitioner in the instant petition.

Hence, petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
