The petitioner, who is appearing in person, is not present in Court today. A perusal of some of the last orders would reflect that the petitioner is not appearing.

The petitioner is alleging violation of the orders dated 28.01.2021 and 06.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-3686-2021 and CRM-M-36533-2019, respectively.

A perusal of the order dated 28.01.2021 shows that the petition was disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab to decide the representations of the petitioner by passing speaking order in

accordance with law.

Reply, filed by way of the affidavit of the Director General of Police, Punjab, is on record, in which it is stated that that the FIR relates to FIR No. 212 dated 17.12.2020, registered under Sections 384, 506 of the IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar. It is further stated that the petitioner was arrested in the said case and later on, one Major Singh filed a petition bearing CRM-M-407-2021 before this Court, in which petitioner Simranjeet Singh was arrayed as a respondent and the said petition was also disposed of on 07.01.2021 with a direction to Director General of Police, Punjab to look into the grievances of Major Singh as well. Thereafter, the investigation of FIR No. 212 was transferred to SSP, Jalandhar (Rural) and the representation of Major Singh was decided by passing a speaking order on 26.02.2021. On 17.03.2021, the SPP, Jalandhar (Rural) has decided the representations of the petitioner as well by giving detailed reasons and on the basis of the report, the Director General of Police, Punjab has passed a speaking order on 01.04.2021.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Subhchain Singh, submits that even a cross case has been registered against Major Singh, vide DDR No. 51 dated 18.01.2021, registered under Sections 323, 325, 34 of the IPC, Police Station Navi Baradari. It is further submitted that the challan has already been presented.

In view of the above, no further action is required in the present petitions and the same are disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to approach the Illaqua Magistrate for redressal of his grievances, if any.

Let a photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected cases.
