Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to immediately stop the second enquiry proceedings with regard to the complaint No.136/B/ADCP/INV dated 23.02.2019 filed by respondent No.4 against the petitioner.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to paragraph No.5 of the status report dated 09.02.2023 filed on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3, which reads as under:-

“ That it is respectfully submitted that thereafter, the Respondent No.4 submitted another representation before the office of the then Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar, in regard to the representation No. 824-Peshi dated 18.10.2018, stating that the some points have not been considered by the Investigating Officer and the same be inquired, the same was endorsed with No.614-PTM dated 18.02.2019. That thereafter, representation was marked by the then Commissioner of Police, District

Jalandhar to the then Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, (Investigation), District Jalandhar.

That on perusal of the above said representation No.614-PTM dated 18.02.2019, the same was recommended to the consigned to record room by the then Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (Investigation), District Jalandhar vide his report dated 21.08.2021, submitted before the then Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar, whereby, it was stated that stated that the subject matter of this representation was similar to that of 824-Peshi dated 18.10.2018 and there was no need of separate inquiry to be conducted on the representation and it was recommended to be consigned to record room. That the abovesiad report was approved by the then Commissioner of Police District Jalandhar and was consigned to record room on 24.08.2021.”

In view of above extracted portion of status report, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the instant petition has been rendered infurctuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
