In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to disposed of as not pressed at this stage. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to raise all the grounds as raised in the present petition before the Trial Court at the appropriate stage.

Keeping in view the attending facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners are at liberty to move an application for their personal exemption, and if such an application is moved, the Trial Court shall consider the same sympathetically.
