The instant petition has been filed for quashing summons dated 02.01.2002, Annexure P-17, whereby the petitioner was directed to appear on 10.01.2002 before the office of the Excise and Taxation Officer, Recovery, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana and deposit a sum of Rs.1,29,594 as balance sales tax for the assessment year 1990-1991 and 1991-1992.

This petition was admitted on 22.03.2002 and there is no interim stay on the summons, Annexure P-17.

On 18.09.2014 when this case taken up, counsel for the petitioner had sought time to seek instructions whether something survives in the present writ petition or not. However, no information has been given by counsel for the petitioner and none has appeared for the petitioner from the last two dates.

The instant petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution
reserving liberty to the petitioner to get it revived within 3 months, if
any, cause of action survives.
