1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is for the grant of compassionate appointment after the death of mother of the petitioner, who was working as Multipurpose Health Worker (female) and unfortunately died on 15.03.2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the reply filed by the respondents, Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 were in operation at the relevant time of the death of the mother of the petitioner according to which rules, there cannot be any compassionate appointment hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the grant of exgratia financial assistance, which benefits the petitioner

can get under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006.
