The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register FIR against the private respondents and further, directions have been sought to decide the representation dated 25.02.2021 (Annexure P-5).

On issuance of notice of motion, the learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Manmohan Singh Aulakh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar Rural, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Para 5 thereof, reads as under:-

“xxx xxx xxx xxx

5. That it is submitted that as per report furnished by SHO, P.S. Majitha, Amritsar Rural, the Enquiry Officer made repeated efforts to join the petitioner No. 1 Ranjit Kaur in the enquiry qua the aforesaid application, but earlier the petitioner No. 1-Ranjit Kaur did not join the enquiry and thereafter the petitioner No. 1 Ranjit Kaur joined the enquiry on 16.01.2023 and stated that they had an altercation with the private respondents and at that time she had given the above said application with exaggerated version due to anger. Thereafter esteemed persons of the village got their compromise effected with each other. Her son Surjit Singh (petitioner No. 3) and her daughter-in-law Jagpreet Kaur are

living safely in their house. Hence, she (petitioner No. 1) does not want to get any action taken upon her application. Therefore, in view of the same the above said application bearing No. 741-PP dated 25.02.2021 (Annexure P/5) has been filed and consigned to record room. The statement of the petitioner No. 1-Ranjit Kaur, report of SHO PS Majitha and report of the deponent are annexed herewith as Annexure R-3/T to R-5/T for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

In view of the stand taken in the status report, particularly in Para 5, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
