**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners who were working as Clerk in the Directorate of Land Records, Panchkula, had worked for a period of three years before they were relieved and keeping in view the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court dated 02.05.2019, four sanctioned posts of Clerks are still lying vacant, hence, the petitioners be given opportunity to represent the Department that in case the work exist, the petitioners should be allowed to continue on these vacant posts.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case any such representation is received, the same will be considered on merits and in case, any post is lying vacant, and work of those posts exist and Department intends to fill those posts, appropriate order on the

representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of such representation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

4. Ordered accordingly.
