Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to incorporate an entry into the revenue record as per Chapter 7 of the Punjab Land Record Manual 1973 read with Section 34 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 with regard to pendency of Civil Suit Bearing CS 182 of 2022 titled as Gurbachan Singh and another Vs. Tilak Raj with regard to property in dispute i.e. Property measuring length on eastern side 96'3", Western side 62'3" width, North 59' and South 47'9" bounded as East property of others, West residential house of the petitioners, North G.T. Road and South property of other bearing Khasra No.29/2/2 and 22/3/2 Khata Khatauni No.50/65 and 66 as per Jamabandi for the year 2018-2019 situated in the revenue estate of Hamidpura Had

Basat No.355 Abadi Guru Nanak Colony, Tehsil and District Amritsar, in accordance with law. Further prayer has been made to decide the application preferred by the petitioners before the respondents to incorporate an entry into the revenue record as per Chapter 7 of the Punjab Land Record Manual 1973 read with Section 34 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 with regard to pendency of Civil Suit bearing CS 182 of 2022 titled as Gurbachan Singh and another Vs. Tilak Raj with regard to property in dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievances, petitioners have filed application dated 06.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar Range, District Amritsar but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent till date.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar Range, District Amritsar is directed to decide the application dated 06.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
