1. This petition is filed quashing of show cause notice dated 10.3.2022.

2. On 26.4.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“This is an application that has been filed for preponing the date of hearing of the main case, which is otherwise fixed for hearing on 19.10.2022.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant-petitioner does not press the instant application.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, it is contended that the petitioner has filed reply to the show cause notice which is pending consideration before respondent No.2, which reply should be considered as expeditiously as possible.

Respondent No.2 to consider the reply filed by the petitioner to the show cause notice within a period of one month from today.”

3. Learned State Counsel submits that he has not received instructions.

4. Petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take a decision on the show cause notice dated 10.3.2022, if not already taken, after considering the reply filed by the petitioner.

5. Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if aggrieved of the decision on show cause notice.

6. Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
