HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed with a prayer that while the petitioner was in service, he was not granted certain benefits, which has resulted into less assessment of pension as well as pensionary benefits hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioner the benefit of the temporary service rendered by him to be treated as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking

order.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the legal notice dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) has not been decided so far, the same will be decided by respondent No.2 within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the legal notice, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him within a further period of four weeks.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
