1. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in the present petitions, challenge is to the action of the respondents directing the petitioners not to come to duties starting from 07.04.1999 with the further

prayer that the petitioners be reinstated in service and they be allowed to continue in service till they are replaced by the regular selected candidates.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are out of service from the last 24 years but once the work on the post on which the petitioners were working still exists, the petitioners will raise a claim before the respondents for their adjustment on the post against which they were working and respondents be directed to decide whether the petitioners can be adjusted against the post on which they were earlier discharging their duties in case the work exists.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners raising the said claim, an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate representation before the respondents.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, is also disposed of.
