This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for withdrawal of the main case with liberty to avail alternate remedy as per law.

Notice of the application.

Mr. G.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel submits that the parties have settled the dispute by way of a compromise way back in the year 2018 but the complainant did not come forward to suffer statement in support of the said compromise. He further states that State has no objection to the limited prayer made in the application being granted, to enable the petitioner to avail his alternate remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the above, no apparent reason has been brought to the notice of the Court for not allowing the limited prayer noticed above, the instant application is allowed.
