DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The petitioners have approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for protecting their lives and personal liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 8.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that both the petitioners are major, aged above 19 years and above 21 years respectively. In support thereof, copies of Aadhaar Cards pertaining to the petitioners have been appended. The learned counsel for petitioners further contends that they have performed marriage against the wishes of their parents. The marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 01.03.2023. Copy of Marriage Certificate (Annexure P-4) and copy of photographs of marriage (Annexure P-4) have also been appended. The petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty and claim that there is a constant danger of being implicated in a false case. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that a representation dated 02.03..2023 (Annexure P-6) has also been sent by the petitioners to the respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur and the same has not been decided till date and they would be satisfied if the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Mr. P.S. Grewal, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on instructions from SI Ranjit Singh, submits that statement of private respondents have been duly recorded, as per which, they have no objection with the marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of, as such.
