1. This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for directing the official respondent to conduct the fair investigation of the FIR No. 369 dated 24.12.2020 registered under Sections 323 and 325 IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and further prayer is not to conduct parallel inquiries.

2. The dispute in the FIR is a result of matrimonial dispute. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions, from ASI Harparshad submits that the investigation is complete and cancellation report is going to be filed within three weeks from today.
