In the present petition, various claims have been raised by the petitioner but at the time of arguments, only one claim has been pressed that the petitioner's case be considered for regularization of his services as VLDA from the date, he had initially joined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the similar benefits have already been granted to the petitioners in CWP No. 4372 of 1996 titled as ***Mahabir Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 21.08.2023, hence the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner also for regularizing his services as VLDA from the date he had initially joined the department so that the petitioner is able to get the further benefit of ACP etc.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming the benefit of regularization of his services as VLDA from an antedate, the same will be considered in accordance with law and the benefit granted to the petitioners in ***Mahabir Singh and others' case (supra)*** will also be kept in mind while passing the speaking order and **appropriate order** will be passed within period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the said benefit will be released to him within a further period of four weeks and the petitioner's claim for the consequential relief will also be considered, if any he is found entitled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
