Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to enter the mutation in favour of the petitioner-firm in terms of sale certificate dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) issued by Punjab and Sind Bank (respondent No.8) exercising the powers conferred under Section 13 read with Rules 8 and 9 of the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules 2002.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that mutation as prayed for in this case, has already been entered by the respondent-authorities and thus, necessary relief prayed for, has already been granted.

In view of the submissions made before this Court, nothing more survives for adjudication as mutation as prayed for has already been entered.
