Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant scale of Rs.13500-17250 to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1996/01.03.1996 alongwith consequential benefits with interest.

Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment dated 06.10.2009 (Annexure P-6) passed by this Court in CWP No.10506 of 2002 titled as '**Dr.K.L.Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**'. Counsel submits that the appeal and SLP against the same has been rejected. Still further, reference has been made by him upon the judgment dated 24.02.2020 (Annexure P-8) to submit that petitioner is similarly placed as the petitioners therein. Despite having submitted repeated representations over the years, respondents have not granted him the due benefit and the

petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr.Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not intend to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Without examining the claim of the petitioner on merits, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 04.02.2020 (Annexure P-17) within a period of four months from the date of communication of copy of this order. In case, respondent No.3 finds that the petitioner is not entitled to the due benefits, an order be passed assigning the reasons for rejection.
