Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that despite the orders passed by the Quasi Judicial Authorities under the Revenue Law, the Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, has sanctioned a mutation in favour of the private respondents.

It is fairly submitted that in an appeal filed by the petitioners, the said order has been set-aside.

Counsel for the respondents have submitted that even a civil litigation is pending between the parties and therefore, the matter is sub judice before the Civil Court as well.

Accordingly, no willful disobedience is made out.

Dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
