Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., to attend the marriage of his real sister, the petitioner seeks interim bail for three weeks in FIR No.158 dated 13.06.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302 and 341 IPC at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

Through order dated 03.03.2023 the Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal (for short, the trial court) permitted the petitioner, in police custody, to attend the marriage of his sister on 11.03.2023 from 9 a.m. till 5 p.m.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the present petition in case this Court permits the petitioner to attend his sister's marriage on 11.03.2023 from 8 a.m. till 6 p.m.

The above prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is considered to be reasonable and therefore, order dated 03.03.2023 passed by the trial court is modified only to the extent that on 11.03.2023 the petitioner, in police custody, shall be taken to the venue where his sister is to get married at 8 a.m. and would be taken back to the jail where he is housed by 6 p.m. on the same day. All other conditions contained in the order dated 03.03.2023 shall remain the same.
