1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.
2. Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and was granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 10.03.2023.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajay Kumar, EOW Jind, Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind, submits that pursuant to order dated 10.03.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
