In view of the facts stated in the application, the order dated 07.09.2021 is recalled. The writ petition is restored to its original number and taken up on Board for final disposal.

Admittedly, there is an award passed by the Arbitrator under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 read with the provisions of National Highways Act, 1956. In terms of the provisions of the National Highways Act, 1956, the procedure laid down in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 is applicable. The award passed by the Arbitrator is executable in terms of Section 36 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner, if so advised, may file the execution petition before the competent court of jurisdiction.
