1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order/letter dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-11) issued by the respondent-University.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has submitted that the petitioner had appeared in the fourth semester examination which took place in May, 2023 and has filed a copy of the result/mark sheet today in the Court which are taken on record and marked as Mark 'A' and 'B'. It is further submitted that the said result would be available in the near future on the website. It is also submitted that the petitioner would also be given provisional degree as well as final degree

along with other students.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the said statement made by learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 satisfies the petitioner but has prayed that the original copy of the result/mark sheet be provided to him and the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. It is further prayed that respondent Nos.1 to 3 be bound by the abovesaid statement.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Respondent Nos.1 to 3 would be bound by the abovesaid statement made before this Court. The original of the mark sheets/result of the petitioner which has been duly signed by the competent authority is in possession of learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 is directed to hand over the same to learned counsel for the petitioner. The same has been done.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
