The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to hold a fair and independent enquiry on the complaint of the petitioner against the private respondent in FIR No.72 dated 02.04.2013 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Nakodar Jalandhar.

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel.

After arguing at length, counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to the extent of issuance of directions to the trial Court to expedite the trial which is hanging fire from the year 2013 and allegations against the private respondents are of instigation and abetment to father of the petitioner who had committed suicide.

Given the nature of the order, this Court proposes to pass, neither response from the State nor issuance of notices to the private respondents are required.

State counsel on instructions submits that the entire evidence has already been recorded, thus trial be expedited.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial on top priority and try to complete it by 31.05.2023.

It is clarified that the petitioner as well as State shall not seek any adjournment before the trial Court, in case they do so, this order stands recalled automatically under Section 362 r/w 482 Cr.P.C. without any further reference to this Court.
