JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 15.03.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of non-bailable warrants dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Moga vide which bail order of the petitioner has been cancelled and bail/surety bonds has been forfeited to the State in case bearing FIR No.257 dated 22.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station City South, District Moga.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of the illness of the father of the petitioner, the petitioner was unable to appear before the Trial Court pursuant to April, 2022, on account of which the impugned order has come to be passed. He submits that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again before the Trial Court immediately.

Notice of motion for 04.05.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Chandi Kusht Ashram Society, Shiv Ram Mandir (Leprosy Colony), Sector 47, Opp. 3 BRD Gate, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim to the satisfaction of Trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has appeared and since been granted bail vide order dated 29.04.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Moga. The copy of the said order is marked as X.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
