This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0016 dated 10.02.2023 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division C, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 13.03.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sulakhan Singh, P.S. Division C, Amritsar, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 13.03.2023 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 13.03.2023 is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence nor influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.
